Purpose:

This document provides attorneys and litigants practicing in the Lindsey-Flanigan courthouse an understanding of the current technology capabilities for the following Court functions:

- HDMI Interface Compatibility
- Showing Evidence on Courtroom TVs
- Showing Evidence on Courtroom Document Camera

Denver County Court operates in courtrooms 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, 3E, 3F, 3G, 3H, 4A, 4B, 4C, 4F located inside the Lindsey-Flanigan courthouse. Please ensure your personal technology is compatible with the courtroom resources to support your litigation needs or bring appropriate adapters or cables to make use of our technology.

Technology:

HDMI Interface:

The courtrooms referenced above have all been equipped with video and audio connections located at the prosecution and defense tables, for the purpose of displaying evidence in the courtroom. These connections require the use of a HDMI video & audio interface (shown below):



Please Note: It is your responsibility to ensure you have the appropriate video and audio designations selected in your personal computer's operating system.

Showing Evidence on Courtroom TVs:

You may use your own personal computer to project to a TV located inside the courtroom. Please consult with the courtroom clerk prior to the start of your trail if you would like to use this feature. The Clerk or Judge may activate the VGA connection at your attorney table.

Showing Evidence on Courtroom Document Camera:

You may also use a Document camera to display objects, paperwork, or other evidence to the courtroom TV. Please consult with the courtroom clerk prior to the start of your trial for document camera use. These document cameras can zoom in directly on an object or paper to display contents to the TV.
