- 1 ONLINE SERVICE ENCOURAGED – CASHIER & GENERAL QUESTIONS** – To make an online payment use the “Pay Ticket” button on www.denvercountycourt.org. - 2 PAYMENT PLANS & COMMUNITY SERVICE** - Setup a payment plan, schedule community service and to ask general questions regarding payment plans and community service, email dcccommunityservice@denvercountycourt.org or call (720) 337 0410, option 4, to leave a message. You may also appear in person at the Lindsey Flanigan Courthouse, Room 160, between 7:30am-4:00pm.

- 6 BONDING OFFICE** – 490 W. Colfax Ave, Main Lobby. Report to bonding office to post bond. Tel: (720) 337 0062

- 8 PUBLIC DEFENDER** – Report as soon as possible or you may lose your right to be defended. You can report to the following locations.

- 10 REVIEW DATE / END OF DEFERRED JUDGMENT** – The court will determine if appearance is required.

- a. Appearance is required
- b. Appearance is NOT required IF all court ordered requirements are completed and proof of completion has been filed with the court in room 160

If proof of completion of all court ordered requirements are not filed with the court, your appearance is mandatory. Failure to appear may result in a warrant for your arrest. The court must be informed of any change of address, telephone number or other contact information.
