- **CASHIER / COLLECTIONS CLERK / COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS** – Room 135, City and County Building, can be reached by calling (720)-865-7840 for general questions between 8am to 6:00pm Monday – Thursday, and Friday 8am – 4pm. To make an online payment use the “make a payment” button on www.denvercountycourt.org. To setup a payment plan, schedule community service, and receive assistance with general questions regarding payments and payment plans call (720) -865-8033 or email dcctrffictcollections@denvercountycourt.org If you are not paying your fines in costs in full, you must contact the collections clerk within 24 hours of sentencing.
